## CITY-WIDE SPRING CLEANUP 7 am May 7th

### CURBSIDE COLLECTION GUIDELINES:

- **Begin Early:** Place your items at the curb one week before collection.
- **Timing Matters:** Ensure items are set out by 7 am on Wednesday, May 7th.
- **Keep Separate:** Appliances should be kept apart from other items.
- **Avoid Stacking:** Do not stack items; crews will not sort through piles of trash
- **Authorized Items Only:** Only place permitted items at the curb.
- **No Late Set-Outs:** Crews will not return for items put out after 7 am on May 7th.
- **Regular Garbage:** Dispose of regular household items on your regular trash pickup day.
- **Collection Restrictions:** Not available for Businesses or apartment complexes with more than two units, No alley pick-up, Permitted items only.

## PRIVATE WATER AND SEWER LINE COVERAGE



Many residents have received letters from companies proposing an optional service line protection plan for the exterior utility lines of their homes.

The City of West Burlington does not endorse specific companies for water or sewer service line coverage. Instead, staff encourages homeowners to conduct their own research to find the best option for their individual needs and to check vendor reputations through the Better Business Bureau.

Here are key points for homeowners to keep in mind:

- Property owners are responsible for the maintenance of their water service lines.
- Service line protection plans are optional and are not officially recognized by the city.
- Homeowners should compare warranty options, considering the age of their home and any potential vulnerabilities.
- Some homeowners' insurance policies may include coverage for service lines as an added benefit.
- Be cautious of misleading marketing that may suggest coverage is mandatory.

- Say no to wiring money to strangers or those demanding wire transfers.

- And no, the IRS will call and ask for payment over the phone.
- Don't click on those links in emails or texts!
- Got a check for more than expected with instructions to send money back? Big red flag!
- Be super careful with money requests from overseas pals.
